

Several thousand Chinese were admitted under special legislation during the world war to work in the cane fields but most | of them soon drifted to Havana where they made their living by operating laundries, keeping small shops and peddling vegetables and merchandise. A number of them also conduct truck farms in the suburbs.

Havana has developed "Chinese Quarter" that extends for several blocks and it is estimated that the city has about 50,000 Chinese.
