Dominion; a dozen buyers repre senting the foremost fur houses in the United States reside here, nd with these in addition to the legal dealers the shipper of furs is always assured of plenty of competition for his peltries. Most of the dealers ship their furs, direct to the eastern provinces; and states, and very often two weeks after the furs have been purchased here they are on the work tables of the manufacturers in Montreal and New York.

In general local dealers state that the trade in furs is healthy. the only "fly in the ointment" is that the traders consider the fur regulations erratic; they express coubts as to what may happen; next and in consequence are neryous.
