ALTERATIONS IN SERVICE

Trains to Leave Here For East at Night Instead of in Morning—To Arrive Later

Effective January 9, a change will be made in the Canadian National Railways train service for Prince Rupert whereby trains will leave here for the east Monday, Wednesday and Friday nights instead of mornings and arrive here from the east later on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday evenings than at present.

Starting January 10, trains will leave here for the east at 9:30 Monday, Wednesday and Friday nights instead of at 9:30 in the mornings as at present.

Commencing January 11, trains will arrive from the east at 10:15 Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday nights instead of at 8 o'clock as at present.

The change in service will permit of connections being made at Red Pass Junction with through trains to and from the east. The same equipment as at present will be used.
