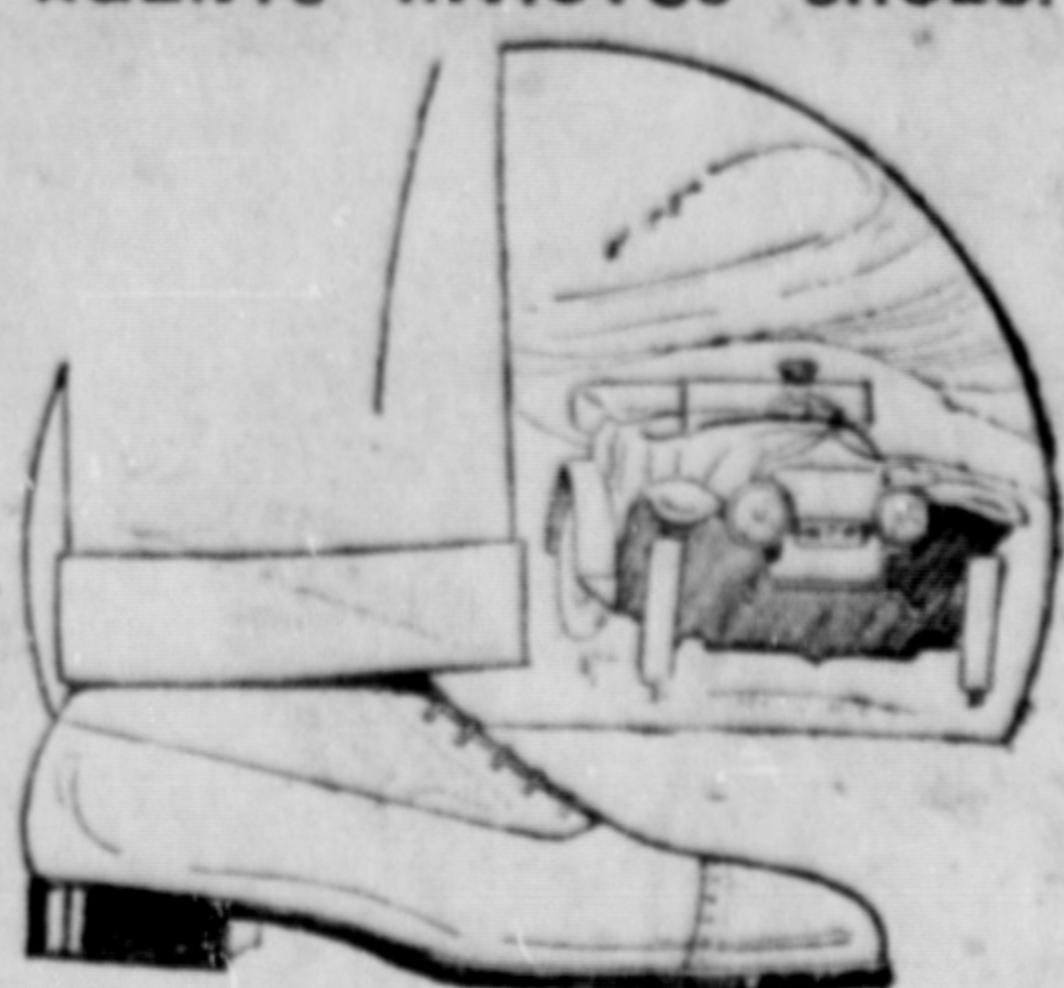

City's 50c an Hour Workers Will Quit Saturday Night Unless Arbitration is Granted

The Oddfellows and St. Andrew's Society whist teams both won their games in the finals of the Men's Section of the Fraternal Whist League last night.

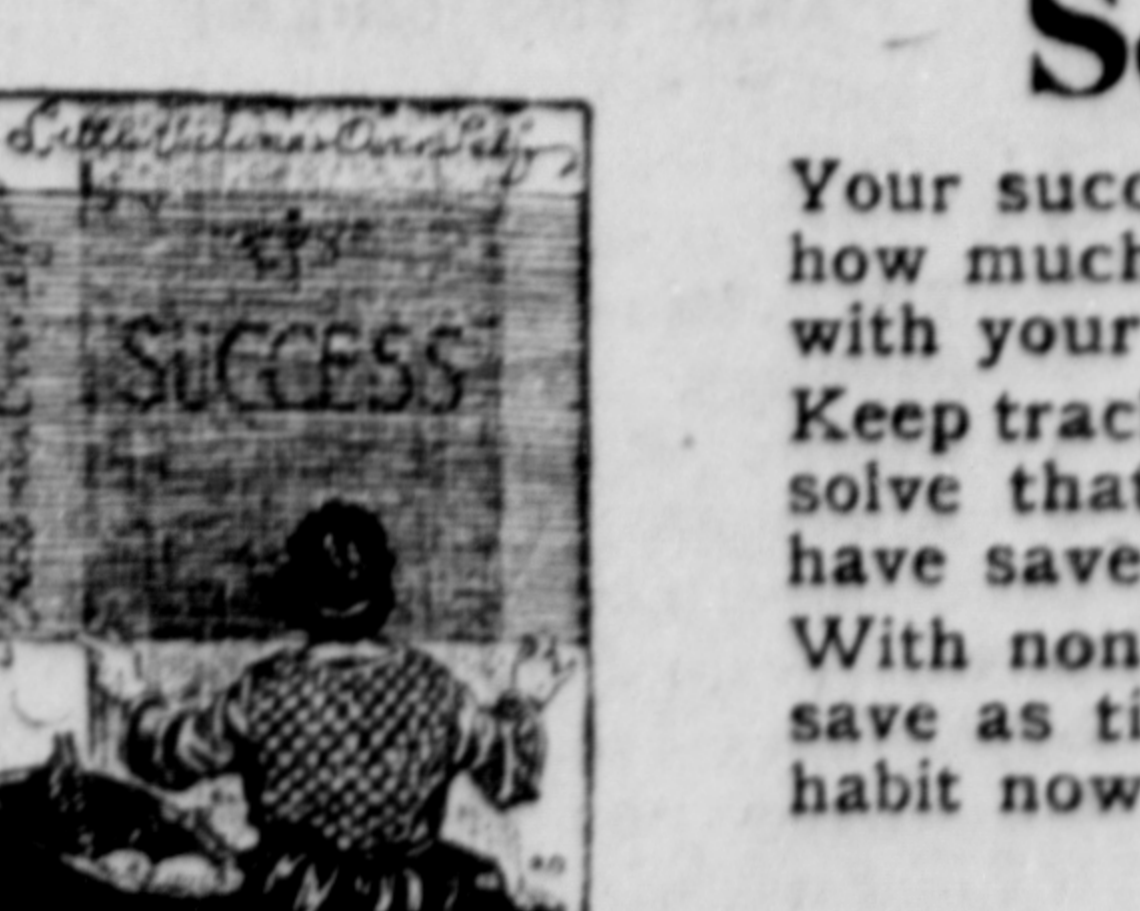
As a result, the Oddfellows and St. Andrew's Society are tied for the league leadership and there will be a sudden death play-off between the two next Thursday to determine the championship.
