MUST PAY \$1 TO DISCONNECT TELEPHONES

Families who have their telephones disconnected temporarily while away on vacations will have to pay \$1 for the privilege under a bylaw introduced in city council last night by utilities committee chairman Robert Mc-Kay. Heretofore, there was no charge for telephone customers seeking temporary disconnection.

At present, a subscriber wishing to suspend the use of their telephone merely have to ask its disconnection which will be done without charge although a minimum rental of \$1 a month wil still be made for the 'phone.

In asking that the additional \$1 disconnection charge be made, Alderman McKay said that such work took up a large part of the telephone department employees; time for which there was no compensation.
