Dominion Bureau of Statistics figures show that Saskatchewan has fewer farms than it had 10. years ago, but those that remain are larger. The number of farms in the province dropped by 11.7 per cent between 1941 and 1951; By definition, a farm now must be at least three acres in size, or from one to three acres, provided it produced at least \$250


worth of produce in 1950. In the all-over total farm area, increases in the prairies and British Columbia outweighted decreases in all the eastern provinces. The number of farms fell in every province except British Columbia.

The bureau said that as the result of the decline in the number of farms and the slight increase in area, the average farm increased about 25 acres over the 10-year period.
