**Airlines Plan Global Weather Information**

MONTREAL — The International Air Transport Association announced here today that creation of a world-wide information service to provide accurate and up-to-date flight data for crews of international airliners was one of the recommendations produced by its annual technical conference held at Nice, France.

Plans for the route intelligence service will be forwarded to the International Civil Aviation Organization for discussion and action. They were drafted by technicians of 20 airline companies from all continents during the 10-day session which closed September 12.

The communications and radio aids group of the conference, surveying the use of ILS, the electronic blind landing system recognized as a standard aid by the international lines, found that early installation has been delayed by shortages of equipment.

It reported, however, that extensive ILS installations should be completed in Europe during 1948; that the United States expects to have 100 ILS systems installed this year; that Canada, the South American countries and many others also are conducting large scale installation programs.
