## Today in Sports

As Canada rang down the curtain on its most successful softball season in history, one pitcher emerged from behind Hamilton's mountain as the Dominion's outstanding contribution to the game—the man of perpetual motion, Russ Johnston. In Cleveland last month a Canadian team — Toronto People's—entered the finals of the world tournament for the first time. They didn't win but even United States competitors recognized Johnston's iron-man mound performances as the feature of the meet. Even his teammates won't hazard a guess at Johnston's age, but he's been burning high, fast ones across the plate for Hamilton and Toronto senior teams for 15 years or so and a conservative estimate is that he's in his 30's.

Russ hurled five games in as many days before he finally lost to the defending world champions, Fort Wayne Zollners. Competing in his ninth world tourney, the husky right-hander won six and lost one game, besides losing 12 points. But before he bowed out with his teammates, Johnston, borrowed by People's from Tip Tops of the Toronto Beaches Fastball League, set down teams from Clearwater, Fla., Washington, D.C., Handford, Calif., St. Joseph's, Mo., and Harlington, Texas. When Johnston's name appeared in the battery day after day, fans wondered why Manager Pete Glen wasn't using his other two moundsmen, Bob McCown and Gordie Wright, but there was good reason. Glen figured that U.S. teams had more trouble with Canadian pitchers than American pitchers and so he kept McCown, who came to Toronto from Columbus, Ohio, in the background. He also found that with the mound three feet further back than in the Canadian game, Wright did not have enough speed and Gordie lost his only start. Russ has hung up his softball togs for the year and headed back to his home in Hamilton where he pitched for years before moving to Toronto this spring and where he helped Hamilton teams to win several Ontario titles. A quiet, modest fellow, Johnston will tell you that the eight other players on People's line-up had as much to do with establishing softball history for Canada as he did. And maybe he's right — outfielder Herb Stricker was voted the tournament's best hitter and Jimmy Rhodes the best fielding outfielder.
