# REPAIR OLD

Sum of \$3,500 to be Spent on Ancient Structure

Prince Rupert's ancient fire nall will be given a new lease on life-estimated at 10 yearsthrough the expenditure of about \$3,500 for structural repairs, re-wiring and installation a new heating system. The decision was made by city counil last i ght.

Problem facing the aldermen was whether or not the building, which was constructed in 1910, was worth a major expenditure in view of the fact it had been condemned by the wiring inspector and given a life expectancy of from five to eight years by City Engineer C. B. Howe.

Mr. Howe setimated that the for a city of this size would be cost of a new fire hall suitable between \$30,000 and \$35,000.

Alderman Arthur Brooksbank recalled that the present fire hall was a "jerry-built" structure when it was erected and declared that it was "unsensible" to spend between \$4,000 and \$5,-000 which he estimated it would cost to put it in proper condi-

City Engineer Howe estimated that structural repairs would cost about \$1,000, consisting mainly of repairing windows and removing the bell tower.

Contract for rewiring the fire hall was awarded to Northern B. C. Power Co. for \$473 plus fixtures. The City Engineer was authorized to proceed with installation of a heating system, which will be let on the basis of \$1,200 plus labor cost.

Contract for re-wiring the second floor of the city Hall was awarded to Wilford Electric Co. for \$306 plus the cost of fix-






