TO DEVELOP INDIAN MINE

Work To Be Resumed On Well Known Property

Development work is expected to commence on the Indian Mines in the Portland Canal District during the latter part of April or early in May. Working capital will be increased. It is planned to proceed along the lines recommended by Dr. J. T. Mandy, consulting engineer. His report estimates tonnage in the present workings at 32,000 tons, averaging 6.1 percent lead, 7.1 percent zinc, 0.13 ounces gold and 5.7 ounces silver per ton.

Bill Irwin of Winnipeg, 27-year old all-round performer and member of the regular Olympic team of 10 already picked, ran the trial as part of his drill for next year's winter games and was third in 1:17.27. Irwin's time was one second better than that of the Canadian cross-country champion, Lauri Hauki, 55-year old Finn from Sudbury.

The only other westerner in the field of 12, Noel Paul of Princeton, took seventh place with a time of 1:19:09 minutes. Paul, already chosen to a spare berth on the Olympic team, lost five seconds getting away because he was adjusting his gear when given the go signal. Harvey Clifford of Ottawa was the only Olympic regular besides Irwin entered in the event and he finished ninth in 1:23:57. Another Olympic star, John Clifford of Ottawa, finished eleventh in 1:25:16.
