

The RCAF-Army rescue team, with Canon Turner, his wife and two children, landed at Winnipeg where the injured missionary was immediately taken to hospital.



DRAMATIC MERCY FLIGHT—End of a seven-week mercy mission by a combined RCAF-Army team came with the safe return to Winnipeg of the injured northland missionary Canon Turner. Above Canon Turner is transferred from "Snowbird." the RCAF Dakota which carried out the hazardous flights, to a waiting ambulance. In peaked cap can be seen Capt. Ross Willoughby, Army paratroop doctor who parachuted into Moffet Inlet to bring aid to the injured man. The return of Canon Turner to civilization was the final chapter in a story that was dominated by the close teamwork of airmen and soldiers of the Joint Air School at Rivers, Manitoba.






