**BATTLESHIP
LOST AT SEA**

But U.S.S. New Mexico,
Going to "Last Battle", Is,
However Found Again

NEWARK, New Jersey—The decommissioned battleship New Mexico, enroute under tow to her "last battle," was lost at sea and found again today forty miles outside of New York Harbor.

Two tugs which cut the 30,000-ton dreadnaught loose in heavy seas yesterday enroute from Boston rushed to take her in tow once more after a Coast-guard plane had located the New Mexico wallowing in the rough Atlantic.

At the entrance of the port of Newark fireboats maintained vigil to keep the former battleship out of Newark after city officials had ordered that no more ships were to be scrapped on the city's waterfront. Fireboats, armed with chemical sprays and water hoses, were sent out to show that the city meant business.

**PATCHING
CHELOHSIN**

Not Yet Known Whether
She Will Be Able to Steam
Herself Back to Vancouver

VANCOUVER—Union Steamship Co.'s steamer Chelohsin, beached at Minstrel Island, 160 miles up the coast following her stranding early Wednesday morning, will be patched up by salvors sufficiently to allow her to be brought back to Vancouver for permanent repairs. Thirty-five members of the crew are still remaining aboard the vessel.

The steamer Catala arrived at Minstrel Island this afternoon to pick up the passengers and complete the Chelohsin's interrupted return voyage on the logging camp run. The Cardena is now on the Prince Rupert run in place of the Catala.

A salvage vessel has also reached the scene.

It is not known as yet whether the Chelohsin will be able to come into Vancouver under her own steam.

Much land between Ecuador and the Gulf of Panama is still unexplored.
