Expected that Unusually Large Orders Will be Placed in Dominion this Winter

TOKIO, Dec. 22.- The movement of Canadian wheat to Japan has resumed again and it! is probable that unusually large orders will be placed by Japanese buyers with the Dominion this winter.

When wheat prices tumbled on the Winnipeg market early in October Japanese buyers placed the bulk of the orders which at | present total about 10,000 tons. Since prices have advanced and there is still some question as to what the Japanese government intends to do about the duty on , wheat entering that country, the buying has dropped off materially, and dealers are wondering how soon Japan will be forced into the market at the prices now prevailing and under the conditions imposed by their own government.

No Stocks Now

If the duty on wheat is doubled in Japan, as was proposed a month or so ago, local exporters are of the opinion that this order would go into effect in November, leaving the importer no! ime in which to cover himself. There are no stocks of grain in

Grain dealers here declare that ! the Japanese market will be forced to buy more in the near future, and last year the consumers of Japan learned the expanding values of Canadian grain, with the result that they ! prefer to buy Canadian hard wheat to the softer grades of the United States.

One Japanese businessman here stated that his countrypeople found that it paid to buy | Canadian wheat as it was hard | and dry, with more to a given! space in a ship, also in weight, than the softer grain that carries moisture and proves expensive shipping without the same expanding values as the Canadian wheat when it arrives at its destination.

Japanese grain prices have been very low recently, but their replacement values exceed the present stock quotations by arge figues. Another feature! oothering exporters is the continual dropping of the yen.
