### NAAS RIVER ROUTE

Mill Bay, Naas River.

In order to avoid inconvenience and unnecessary discomfort to future travellers to Aiyansh and the Upper Naas District, will you please be good enough to publish a warning that owing to the fact that these premises will be vacated within the next two weeks it will no longer be possible to provide accommodation for those landing here from the Union Steamship en route to up river points. All those travelling this way are advised to first ascertain from the Postmaster at Prince Rupert the exact date on which the Aiyansh mail boat is due at Mill Bay and then to equip themselves with a camping outfit before leaving Prince Rupert.

## SYNOPSIS OF LAND ACT AMENDMENTS

### PRE-EMPTIONS

Vacant, unreserved, surveyed Crown lands may be pre-empted by British subjects over 18 years of age, and by aliens on declaring intention to become British subjects, conditional upon residence, occupation, and improvement for agricultural purposes.

Full information concerning regulations regarding pre-emption is given in Bulletin No. 1, Land Series, "How to Pre-empt Land," copies of which can be obtained free of charge by addressing the Department of Lands, Victoria, B.C., or to any Government Agent.

Records will be granted covering only land suitable for agricultural purposes, and which is not timberland, i.e., carrying over 5,000 board feet per acre west of the Coast Range and 4,000 feet per acre east of that Range.

Applications for pre-emption are to be addressed to the Land Commissioner in the Land Recording Division, in which the land applied for is situated, and are made on printed forms, copies of which can be obtained from the Land Commissioner.

Pre-emptions must be occupied for five years and improvements made to value of \$10 per acre, including clearing and cultivating at least five acres, before a Crown Grant can be received.

### PURCHASE

Applications are received for purchase of vacant and unreserved Crown lands, not being timberland, for agricultural purposes; minimum price of first-class (arable) land is \$5 per acre, and second-class (grazing) land \$2.50 per acre. Further information regarding purchase or lease of Crown lands is given in Bulletin No. 10, Land Series, "Purchase and Lease of Crown Lands."

Mill, factory, or industrial sites on timber land, not exceeding 40 acres, may be purchased or leased, the conditions including payment of stampage.

### HOMESITE LEASES

Unsurveyed areas, not exceeding 30 acres, may be leased as homesites, conditional upon a dwelling being erected in the first year, title being obtainable after residence and improvement conditions are fulfilled and land has been surveyed.

### LEASES

For grazing and industrial purposes areas not exceeding 640 acres may be leased by one person or a company.

### GRAZING

Under the Grazing Act the Province is divided into grazing districts and the range administered under a Grazing Commissioner. Annual grazing permits are issued based on numbers ranged, priority being given to established owners. Stock-owners may form associations for range management. Free, or partially free, permits are available for settlers, campers and travellers, up to ten head.

## NEW CLUB HOUSE FOR G.W.V.A. AT SMITHERS

Structure Almost Completed Has Fine Auditorium as Well as Rooms for Members

SMITHERS, Sept. 8.—The G.W.V.A. branch of Smithers has almost completed its new club house. The building, which is situated on Broadway, immediately off Main Street, is of very pleasing architectural design, taken from the period of King James and Queen Anne, and bearing of a militaristic character is most suitable to this class of building.

The interior of the building is particularly adapted to the purpose in view, being fitted out with library, club room, card rooms, etc., and caretakers quarters, while the entire upper storey is given over to an auditorium.

The architect is F. Ockleshaw, of Smithers, and the building contractor J. P. Downey. The painting and decorating is in the hands of Geo. Orchard, and L. S. Davies is the electrical contractor.





## BANDIT WOMAN IS EXECUTED

Endures Torture of Slicing for  
Horrible Crimes Committed  
by Her

SHANGHAI, Sept. 8.—"Old Mother" Djao, said to be the most notorious and bloodthirsty bandit the province of Shantung ever produced, has been executed at Ichowfu in Shantung, according to reports received in Shanghai by mission organizations. These advises add that the dreaded female bandit underwent that most fearsome of Chinese death penalties, the ling-che, or
