

VIENNA (Reuters)-Newspapers here report that an Austrian woman who claims to have the oldest postage stamp in the world has turned down an offer of \$120,000 for it.

The paper Neuses Oesterreich said she is dickering around a figure of \$155,000 with Swiss and Austrian dealers.

She refuses to disclose her name or how she got the stamp. A panel of experts claim it is authentic, issued 1830-10 years before the British "Penny Black," hitherto acclaimed as the first official government-backed postage stamp.


