# OF GASLESS AIRPLANE

Frenchman Usees Novel Type of Engine in Going from Paris to Lyons

PARIS, May 21 .- Lieut. Batelof the French Aerial Service last week made a sensational flight from Paris to Lyons with a new type of engine, called a "turbo compressor." It does not use gas and is worked by a series of copper tubes, through which air rushes, causing a suction, which works a number of small pumps, which forces the pistons to work in the same manner as ordinary airplane engine. Lieut, Bateller reached an altitude of more than 18,000 feet and an average speed of 137 miles an hour.
