## CANADIAN LAW BENEFIT ALASKA

Open Market for Halibut at Prince Rupert Brings Prosperity to Ketchikan

In an article advocating support for Dan Sutherland's reelection to Congress, the Alaska Fisherman speaks of the prosperous condition of the halibut industry as follows:

"The splendidly prosperous condition that now obtains in the halibut fishing industry should awaken the people of the Territory to the fact that the same conditions that prevail in halibut fishing can be made to apply to other branches of fishing and there is no good reason why they should not apply.

"You cannot today find a single halibut fisherman who is dissatisfied with conditions that govern his branch of fishery but on the contrary every halibut fisherman you meet is loud in his words of approval of these conditions.

"There is no monopoly in the halibut fishery either in fishing or marketing. All halibut is sold in open competitive market and as the demand for this fish is strong, good prices are paid to the fishermen for their catch.

It was indeed a fortunate day for the halibut fishermen of the North Pacific when the Poindexter amendment to close the market at Prince Rupert and create a monopolistic market at Ketchikan was defeated in the U.S. Senate. It was also a fortunate day for the town of Ketchikan, as the contentment with present conditions on the part of the halibut fishermen is evidenced in the increase of trade at this port. A satisfied, contented people is the object of civil government, and the purpose of laws is to bring about that social condition.

"If laws have brought about the conditions that obtain in the halibut industry, why is it not possible to correct conditions in the salmon fishery in the same manner? When the laws are enacted for the abolishment of all monopolistic methods of fishing and marketing salmon then will the same satisfactory conditions prevail in that branch that are so noticeable in the halibut fishery."

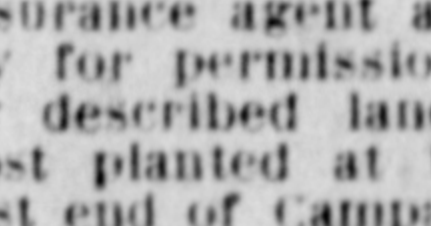
