No Super-Scientific Stuff for Mr. Fusty

If you play a lot outside of your own circle, you run into quite a few players like Mr. Fusty. None of the "super scientific" stuff for him. He prides himself on using old-fashioned bidding methods. Why, it is hard to say.

Give him enough (barely enough, sometimes) for an opening bid, strength in as many as three suits and no suit of five cards or more and he makes what looks to him like the natural opening—one no trump.

If you don't know how to handle Mr. Fusty as a partner, it will pay you to learn. Mr. Dale says, "Look at the players first, then look at the cards." When playing with Mr. Fusty, he plays the Fusty system.

For that reason, he raised to two no trump, not three no trump, in today's deal. He knew that if Mr. Fusty had a really good hand he would bid again, and if he didn't, he would pass.

Against the two no trump contract, Mrs. Keen led the eight of hearts, dummy played small and Mr. Champion won with the 10 and cashed the ace. He returned a club which was taken on the board with the queen.

Next came the king of spades and Mr. Champion won with the ace and led back a second club. Mr. Fusty won with the ace. He had eight tricks in sight and this point and the only chance for more seemed to lie in the diamond suit.

He led a small diamond hoping to duck it into Mr. Champion's hand but Mrs. Keen put up the ten. Dummy's king won and here Mr. Champion made a nice play, dropping the queen. If he had retained that card, he would have had to play it on the next diamond lead and would have been permitted to win with it.

Mr. Fusty could then have won any return and cashed two more diamond tricks. As it was, Mrs. Keen won the third round of diamonds and made her king.
