BLACKWOOD on Bridge

Mr. Fusty's Not Such a Rusty Player

Mr. Fusty's play is good but he steadfastly holds to bidding methods which go back to auction days. With no five card suit and strength in at least three suits, he insists on opening the bidding with one no trump. Even a singleton does not deter him.

True, many pairs would reach three no trump, probably on the following bidding:

South	North
1C	1D
1H	2D
1NT	3NT

Fortunately for him, Mr. Fusty's play makes a lot more sense than his bidding. He got a club opening which he won in his own hand with the king. He then led the queen of diamonds and overtook with the dummy's king when Mr. Champion played low.

How would you play from here on? Obviously, the diamond suit must be brought in if there is to be any chance for the contract. The nine spot is of major importance. If the ace of diamonds is doubleton, then the right play at trick three is a low diamond. The ace will fall and the jack and 10 will pick up the nine spot.

Mr. Fusty knew this play was against the percentages. In other words, if he led the jack of diamonds next, he could set the suit if the nine were doubleton or if the nine were held three long. Two to one, then, in favor of leading the jack.

Mr. Champion won the second diamond and fired another

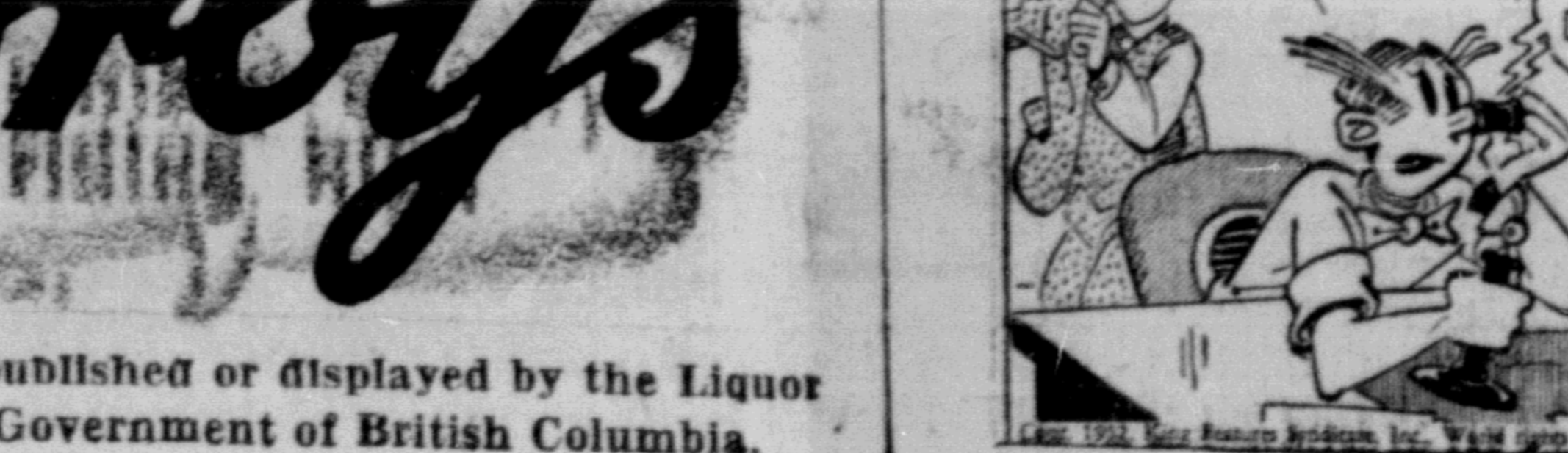
