

BYLAW NO. 476

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE EARLY CLOSING OF SHOPS PURSUANT TO THE "SHOPS" REGULATION ACT...

WHEREAS a petition has been presented to the Municipal Council of the City of Prince Rupert...

AND WHEREAS it has been proven to the satisfaction of the City Council...

AND WHEREAS the classes of shops referred to in the said petition are...

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT ENACTS AS FOLLOWS...

1. In this bylaw the word "person" shall mean and include any body corporate or firm...

Words importing the singular number of the masculine gender only shall include more persons, parties, or things...

2. In the construction of this bylaw, and for the purpose of classification of shops as provided by section 7 of the "shops" Regulation Act...

(a) "Hardware and Sporting Goods Shop" shall mean and include all shops or stores in which, as to the whole or any part of the business carried on therein...

(b) "Electrical Shop" shall mean and include all shops or stores in which, as to the whole or any part of the business carried on therein...

(c) "Stationery Shop" shall mean and include all shops or stores in which, as to the whole or any part of the business carried on therein...

(d) "Dry Goods Shop" shall mean and include all shops or stores in which, as to the whole or any part of the business carried on therein...

(e) "Clothing Shop" shall mean and include all shops or stores in which, as to the whole or any part of the business carried on therein...

(f) "Butcher Shop" shall mean and include all shops or stores in which, as to the whole or any part of the business carried on therein...

(g) "Grocery Shop" shall mean and include all shops or stores in which, as to the whole or any part of the business carried on therein...

(h) "Pastry Shop" shall mean and include all shops or stores in which, as to the whole or any part of the business carried on therein...

(i) "Furniture Shop" shall mean and include all shops or stores in which, as to the whole or any part of the business carried on therein...

(j) "Millinery Shop" shall mean and include all shops or stores in which, as to the whole or any part of the business carried on therein...

(k) "Bakery Shop" shall mean and include all shops or stores in which, as to the whole or any part of the business carried on therein...

(l) "Musical Shop" shall mean and include all shops or stores in which, as to the whole or any part of the business carried on therein...

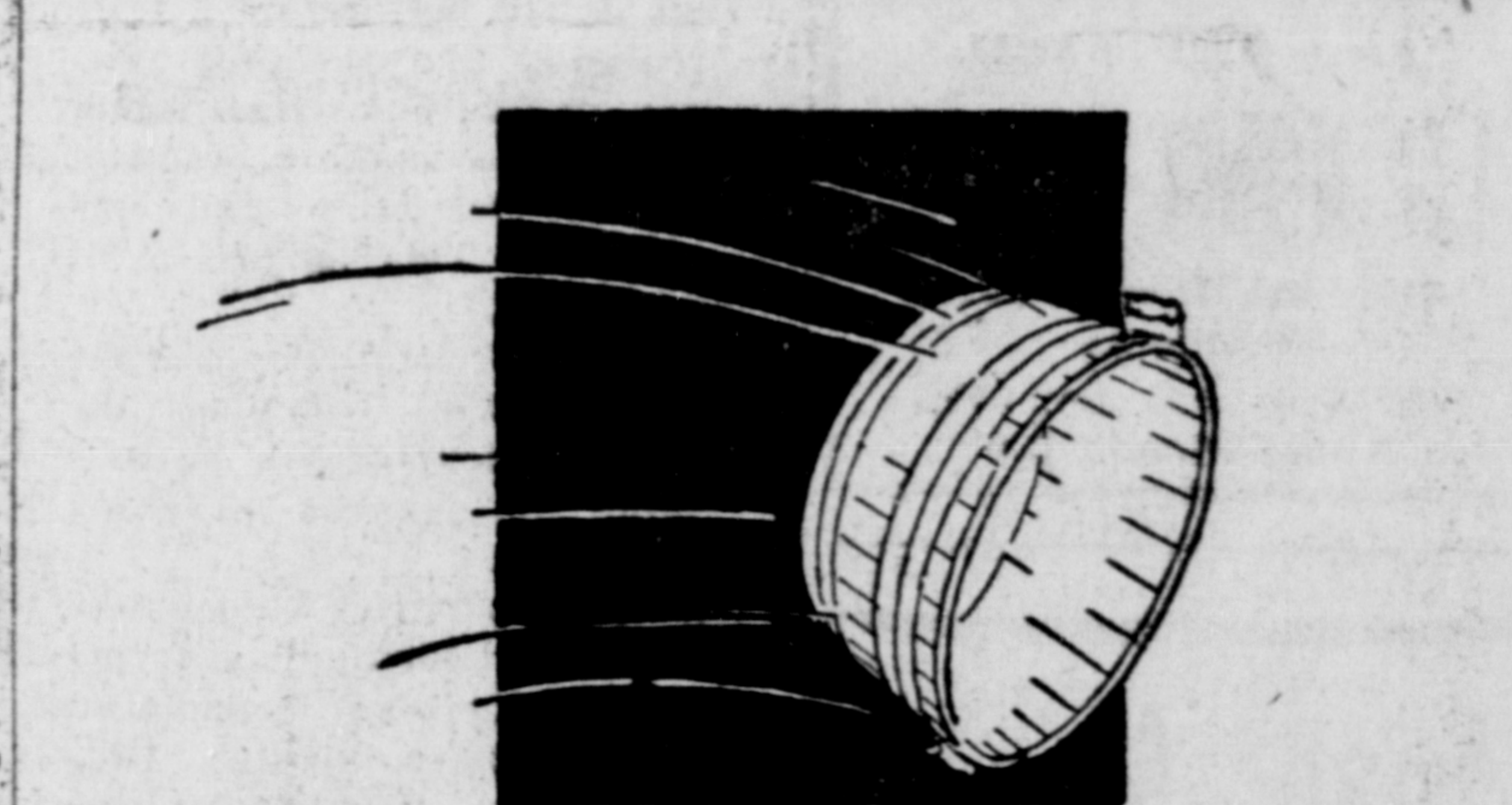
