BYLAW NO. 476

BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE EARLY CLOSING OF SHOPS PURSUANT TO THE "SHOPS' REGULATION ACT," CHAPTER 211 REVISED STATUTES OF BRITISH COLUMBIA, 1911, AND AMEND

WHEREAS a petition has been presented; to the Municipal Council of the City of Prince Rupert praying for the enactment of this Bylaw,

AND WHEREAS It has been proven to the satisfaction of the City Council that said petition is signed by not less of business not less than three-quarters of the persons carrying on each such

AND WHEREAS the classes of shops referred to in the said petition are: Hardware and Sporting Goods, Electrical, Stationery, Drygoods, Glothiers, Butchers, Grocers, Paint, Furniture, Millinery, Boot and Shoe, Bakery and Musical Shops, NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT ENACTS AS

1. In this bylaw the word "person" shall mean and include any body corporate or politic, or party, and the heirs, executors, administrators, successors, or other texal representative of such person to whom the context can apply according to

Words importing the singular number or the masculine gender only shall include more persons, parties, or things of the same kind than one, and females as well as males, and the converse, 2. In the construction of this bylaw, and for the purpose of classification of shops

as provided by Section 7 of the "Shops" Regulation Act," the following classificaions are hereby declared and enacted, that (a) "Hardware and Sporting Goods!

used for games or sport

by retail electrical goods, such as lamps Sytures, fittings, wire fuses, switches, halls, conduits, clusters, knobs lock-nuts, loom, medical batteries, plugs, socketetc., or any of the class of goods known the trade as electrical goods. (c) "Stationery Shop" shall mean and include all shops or stores in which as the whole or any part of the business carried on therein, there are offered

for sale by retail books, stationery, pic-(d) "Drygoods Shop" shall mean and include all stores or shops in which, as to the whole or any part of the business or any millinery, clothing, or wearing apparel manufactured suitable for the wear (e) "Clothiers Shop" shall mean and in-

carried on therein, there are offered for sale by retail, men's clothing or boys' clothing, ee any part of the class of goods known to the trade as "Gents' Furnishings whether for men or boys. (f) "Butcher Shop" shall mean and inrlude all shops or stores in which, as to the

ried on therein, there are offered for sale by retail meat or fish. (g) "Grocer Shop" shall mean and include all shops or stores in which, as to

sale by retail a stock of groceries. The following list of articles shall be classed as groceries: Almonds (ground), almond paste, apthe butter, arrowroot, bacon, baking powder, beans (dried), bird gravel, bird seed biscults blueing, breakfast foods, butter canned fish, canned fruit, canned meat ranned vegetables, capers, catsup, celery salt, cheese, chicory, chocolate (cooking) chuiney, cleaning powders, cocoa, cocoa-
