## GETTING AFTER THAT ELEVATOR

Prince Rupert Could Help Strengthen Hands of Local Representatives

### MATTER IS DISCUSSED

Newspaperman and Others Urged to Visit Port and Secure Information

"The one thing we must get after and insist on having this year is an elevator," declared H. F. Pullen, who returned home yesterday from a holiday spent in Victoria and Vancouver, during which time he interested himself to some extent in the needs of Prince Rupert. In pressing the claims of the city on the Ottawa authorities he thinks the aid of the farmers of Alberta and the grain shippers of the prairies should be enlisted.

Noticing by the Vancouver papers that J. D. O. Mothersill was in Vancouver investigating the high charges on grain shipping through the port of Vancouver and realizing the advantage of keeping Prince Rupert to the fore in that regard, Mr. Pullen accompanied R. Beaumont, superintendent of the G.G.M.M. at this port, to interview Mr. Mothersill and try to get him to return to Edmonton by way of Prince Rupert and investigate conditions at this port and incorporate them in his report. Mr. Beaumont explained the special advantages of this port. He showed that while high charges were necessary in Vancouver in order to meet the interest and sinking fund on the cost of sites, and the harbor improvements and cost of operation, there were no such charges in Prince Rupert. The commissioner had already admitted that these charges in Vancouver were just.

### Competitive Port

It was pointed out to Mr. Mothersill that in utilizing Prince Rupert as an additional port the charges would be evaded and a competitive port would be developed, which in itself would be a great advantage to the prairie shippers. It was also well to have two strings to a
