NORTHERN TURNIPS PARTICULARLY GOOD

Vancouver Paper Comments on Quality of Produce From Woodcock

The Vancouver Province which arrived today says:

With potatoes high many people are taking to other vegetables as a substitute. Turnips are being favored more for table use and at a price to the retail trade of around \$30 a ton are being more sought after. Turnips on the track at Vancouver are bringing around \$25 a ton, but some specially good swede varieties, brought in from Woodcock, about ninety miles east of Prince Rupert, are much higher. The wholesale price to the retail trade for this class of turnip being quoted at \$3.00 a sack.

The turnips were sold in Vancouver by Sid Thompson during the Christmas holidays when he visited that city. It is the third shipment made by him this season from Woodcock and Cedarvale.

CANADIAN WINNER IN FROM ORIENT

C.G.M.M. Vessel Spent Night in Port and Proceeded to Swanson Bay to Load Lumber

C. G. M. M. steamer Canadian Winner, Capt. N. P. Hoeking, arrived here from Shanghai last night at 7 o'clock to enter and clear and, after spending the night anchored in the harbor, sailed at 8 o'clock this morning for Swanson Bay where she will load one million feet of lumber for Boston, later going to Vancouver and the island to complete cargo.

Capt. Hoeking reported a fast and uneventful passage of 21 days across the Pacific Ocean from Shanghai. The vessel is light. She was picked up at Triple Island by Capt. E. McDoonick and piloted in here and thence to Swanson Bay.

STRIKE IS TYING UP ISLAND OF TASMANIA

Federal Government Takes Over Steamer Plying to Island and Advertises For Crew

MELBOURNE, Jan. 16.—Tasmania is running short of supplies owing to the waterfront workers' strike.
