**HAYSPORT MISSING SAYS SEATTLE PAPER**

Left Vancouver on January 10 and Had Not Arrived Thursday

In the issue of Thursday the Ketchikan Chronicle says:

Some anxiety is felt for the motorship Haysport, which left Vancouver, B.C., on January 10, according to reports, bound for Skagway with a cargo of powder for the White Pass railroad. Inquiry was received in Ketchikan today as to whether the ship had ever entered here from the south.

At the customs office it is said that the ship might have gone on the Juneau or Skagway to enter, but it is not believed likely, as nothing had been heard of it at Juneau. That has been definitely ascertained. Inquiries are being sent south today to see if anything is known of why it has not arrived.

Inquiry is also being made among the fishing fleet, many vessels of which just returned from the south.
