Queen May Pick Colorful Items for Coronation Day

LONDON (CP)—When Queen Elizabeth II returns from Scotland in October, final decisions will be made on the Royal Regalia for the coronation next June. Meanwhile there is considerable speculation.

Many believe that the purple velvet robe of state in which the queen leaves Westminster Abbey to drive through the streets will bear emblematic gold embroidery like that of a queen consort. Kings don't wear embroidered robes of state, leaving this to their queen and her mistress of the robes—traditionally a duchess.

Such embroidery is dictated by national commonwealth traditions, and its form is settled by the coronation council. The six-yard-long robe worn at her coronation by Queen Mother Elizabeth was embroidered at the Royal School of Needlework.

FABULOUS ROBE

Lined and bordered in ermine, it is worth several thousand pounds and was recently placed in Kensington Palace museum, together with the coronation robes of the late king.
