of the child. Johnson had even asked if Mrs. Bailey could give the child a home after he had regained it. He had not seen Johnson again until the morning of the incident in question when he had come to the police station and, stating that arrangements had been made for him to regain possession of the child, had asked him (Bailey) to accompany him as a witness. They proceeded to the hotel and Bailey remained in the corridor while Johnson proceeded to Mrs. Johnson's room. He saw the child between Johnson and Mrs. Johnson and it was crying. He had warned Johnson not to make the child cry and then Johnson had made off with the screaming baby in his arms. He denied obstructing Mrs. Johnson at any time. Following Johnson down the stairs, Bailey had asked that the crying child be given to him. They proceeded to Besner's house where he (Bailey) saw the child safely delivered. This was recorded at the time in the
