**MUSICAL MARAUDERS
CONSTANTLY STEALING**

Makers of Modern Popular Num-
bers Accused of Lifting
Strains of Masters

(Montreal Gazette)
"You've been lying to me," is
the reproach levelled by one
character at another in a current
musical comedy success.

"That's no news, I knew it all
the time," is the retort of the ac-
cused. Some such answer will
probably be the defence of the
song-writers of the United States
to the charge made against
them by the opponents of the
proposed copyright bill at Wash-
ington, which is to the effect
that most of their compositions
are wholly unoriginal, being
lifted bodily from older music
ranging all the way from almost
forgotten popular songs or once
favorite melodies to classic and
religious music by the great
masters.

Nor will the charge
occur much surprise on the
part of the general public, for
anyone with an average ear for
tunes, a cursory knowledge of the
music, good or otherwise, of
the past, and a memory going
back more than a decade, has
been able to note of recent years
an increasing tendency on the
part of the makers of melodies
for the masses to lift most of
their material by wholesale.

Sometimes the appropriation
has been open and acknowledged,
as in the case of "The Love
Song," dealing with the career
and personality of Offenbach

and employing his music liberally
as settings for its numbers,
and its now famous predecessor,
"Blossom Time," in which Schu-
berl's immortal strains are
adapted to lyrical uses, sometimes
with odd effect, as when
"The Unfinished Symphony," is
wrenched from its proper tempo
and made to cavort in waltz
measure.

Just Theft

But in most cases it is not a
matter of borrowing but of de-
liberate theft, and the theatre-
goers, the dancers and the radio
fans of today have their ears
filled by supposedly original
and up-to-date compositions
which in large part are made up,
note after note and bar after
bar, of music which was as
familiar to their fathers, moth-
ers and grandparents as was
"God Save the Queen." Number-
less examples could be cited,
but it is enough to mention Al
Jolson's "Avalon," which is com-
pounded in almost equal parts
of "Oh Promise Me" and an
aria from "La Tosca," and which
led the recently-deceased com-
poser Puccini to enter suit for
infringement.
