## Fishermen Seek Support For Federal Aid VICTORIA (P) - A delegation

from the United Fishermen and Allied Workers' Union Tuesday asked the cabinet for support of a three-point program aimed at easing price and employment problems caused by the province's huge unsold salmon pack.

Latest estimate of the unsold stock is 650,000 cases. The fishermen asked:

1. That the Federal government take emergency action to provide practical assistance to the industry in financing and storage of canned salmon carryover, and in marketing of the pack to meet government-subsi dized competition of other food products.

2: That the Federal government submit proposals to the coming Commonwealth conference in London which will remove all currency restrictions in trade between Canada and the sterling countries of the Commonwealth.

3. That the Federal gove nment open for revision at the coming session the Fisheries' Prices Support Act of 1945, in order to provide for fishermen of B.C. a practical means of assistance to maintain living standards and to prevent distress.
