FLOUR AND FEED LINES ARE DOWN

Egg Market Is Stiffening With Shortage of Supply—Sugar Price Drops

The principal change in the market report during the past two weeks has occurred in flour and feed lines. Flour is down \$1.10 since the middle of last month. Owing to heavy rains of the past month, threshing on the prairies has been delayed and this may have a bad effect on crops which a month ago were expected to be record breakers in some districts.

The past fortnight has seen a gradual stiffening in the price of eggs. Shortage of supplies and extraordinary demand has placed poultrymen in a position where they may demand high prices. Unless a heavy increase in production occurs, prices will remain high for some time as the market can easily absorb all offerings.

The sugar market has declined 20¢ per hundred during the past fortnight.
