

## WATERFRONT WHIFFS

Fishing industry has shown much activity during week; pinks running everywhere; salvage people busy

Good reports have been received this week regarding the fishing industry generally in District No. 2. The volume of salmon fished during the week under review has kept up well and is in excess of the quantity landed during the previous week. Saturday a total of 121,000 pounds was landed, followed by 11,500 pounds on Monday, 125,500 pounds on Tuesday, 67,000 pounds on Wednesday, and 80,000 pounds on Thursday, while yesterday seven American and four Canadians landed 147,000 pounds. Prices have remained steady around 16c and 9c for American caught fish and around 8c and 8c for Canadian caught, while in some instances Canadian fish has picked off a little better prices than the Americans.

It was reported on Thursday at a big run of pinks is being experienced at Massett, Queen Charlotte Islands, and that the canneries on the islands are working day and night to cope with the catch. It was reported by one person, arriving on the Prince Charles on Thursday, that a net, with one end tied to the wharf and the other end dragged around by a gasboat, caught over 20,000 fish in one swoop. While a few cohoes are running in the rivers, this run is not expected to mature to any extent until the latter part of the month. The run of pinks in the Skeena and Nass Rivers has started off in good shape and is much improved over the corresponding period last year. It is the consensus of opinion in nautical circles that this fall will be one of the busiest in the city's history as there are more fishermen out this year than ever before and the canneries throughout the district are running with heavy crews.
