# IMMENSE WHALE CATCH IS MADE

Rose Harbor Station Being Jammed with Mammals—General Activity on Islands

## PRINCE JOHN IN FROM SOUTH END

Sitka Spruce Mill at Queen Charlotte City Working Full Blast

An unprecedented catch of whales is being taken at the Rose Harbor station of the Consolidated Whaling Corporation this season according to word brought to the city this morning on the steamer Prince John. Well over 100 of the big mammals have been taken so far at the station, the catch coming in so fast that the plant is being operated almost on a day and night basis and, at that, about all that can be done is to strip the monsters of their blubber. When the John passed Naden Harbor, there were nine whales lying in the water awaiting entry to the plant.

Officers of the Prince John also reported that the new cannery of the B.C. Packers at South Bay is being rushed to completion so as to be ready for the coming season. The vessel brought up 7,000 cases of cans for the plant.

Carmichael beat Arnott 6-0 6-4 in the second round and Nicholls beat Youngman 6-3 6-0.

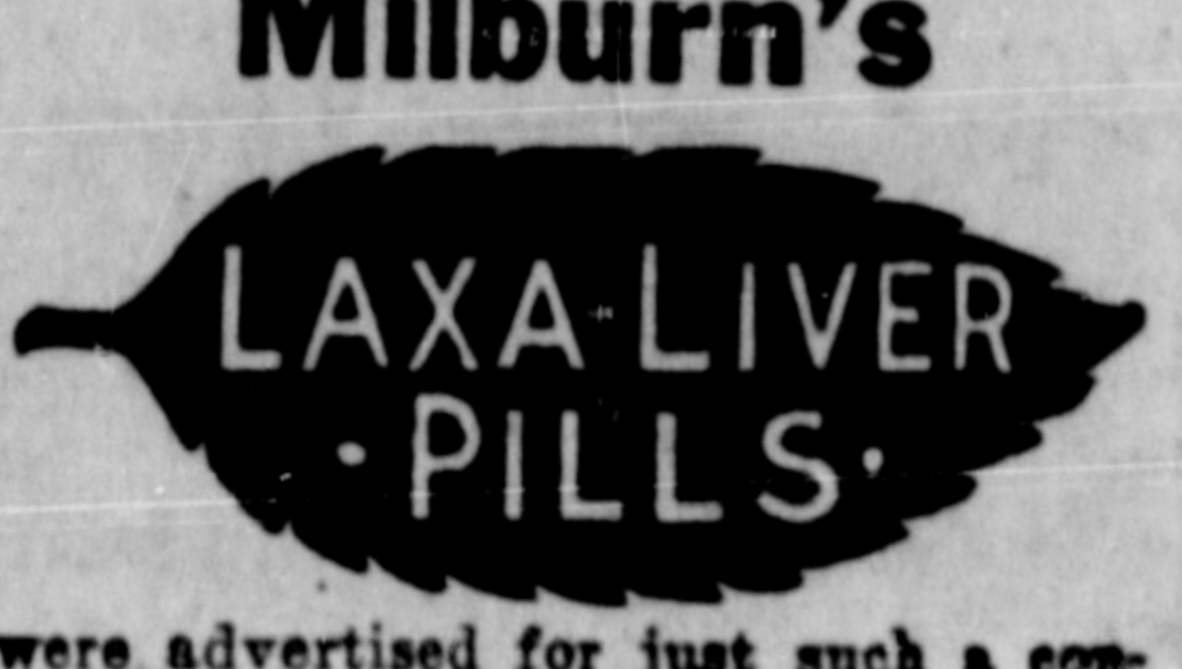
# POPULATION OF INDIA IS 350 MILLIONS
