

## Whooping Cough Deadly \_\_\_ For Younger Children

> "Of the various infectious diseases encountered today, whooping cough presents the chief problem from the standpoint of reduction - in mortality." spokesman for the National Immunization Week committee of the Health League states.

To make protection easier for both parents and children, combination of whooping cough vaccine and diphtheria and lockjaw toxiod can now be given either by the family doctor or at public health clinics.

"It is the clear duty of every parent to see that no child runs the needless risk of death from one of these preventable diseases," declares Dr. Gordon Bates, general director of the Health League of Canada. "Indifference on the part of parents to the need for immunization is nothing short of criminal neglect!"
