

To many Canadians, talk of 'the Ashes' is somewhat mystifying. "The Ashes" are the only symbol of victory in these great biennial tests. They are contained in a little urn and are madeby burning one of the wicket stumps used in the matches. The symbol was presented to Lord Darnley in 1882 when he took an English team to Australia for the first time and defeated the "Downunders."

The idea of "the Ashes" came from a cartoon published in the Sporting Times earlier in the same year. New Turnover Levy Suggested for the Province Would Replace Personal Property Tax.

Before the Rotary Club Thursday afternoon, Walter Fisher, provincial tax collector, outlined to the members the proposed new tax which it is suggested may ake the place of the present personal property tax. He stated that ! the provincial government was lanxious to secure the views of the business people in regard to this and would welcome suggestions with a view to having them! incorporated as a part of the law. Mr. Fisher said it had been ob-

jected to the property tax that it was inequitable. Still he personally thought it would be a serious! matter to eliminate a tax until mature consideration had been given the matter and until proper ways and means of replacing! it had been discovered.

Property Tax The main objections to the personal property tax were that often the tax increased as the business decreased for the reason hat larger stocks were left on and. Some merchants, through the nature of their business had to carry ten times as great a stock as others with a larger turnover and larger profit. Often the tax on business conducted by Orientals and others was inadequate to the amount of turnover and lastly the tax was colllected at a time of year when it

could least be afforded and some-

times at the end of an unprofit-

able year. Mr. Fisher then went on to show the impracticability of operating under a net income tax and outlined the proposed turnover tax which was to operate in connection with the income tax much as the personal property tax does today. It was to be a base minimum tax on which collections would be made monthly. The merchant would have to show his gross turnover and turn in a remittance on it. At the end of the year the net income would be declared and if a profit was shown it would be subject to the income tax and the collections made monthly would be credited on it.
