IMMIGRATION MUCH GREATER

Record in Post-War Arrivals Has Been Made and all are of Good Type

LOW RATE ATTRACTIVE Practically all Arrivals are Placed on Farms and Will be Good Settlers


MONTREAL, April 16.—"What may be termed a record in post-war immigration to Canada, has been established in the period from the beginning of the year to the present date," said Dr. W. J. Black, director of the department of colonization, agriculture and natural resources of the Canadian National Railways.

Many British "This justifies our policy of bringing in only suitable types of people who will finally decide to farm for themselves and eventually make good on the land. There has been a distinct British flavor to the flow of immigrants this year, one boat arriving with 57 British families to be placed directly on farms of their own."
