# BYNG CHERISHES LOCAL MEMENTO

Interesting Circumstance Led up to Writing of Letter Received by Ex-Mayor Rochester

Odd and interesting circumstances having led up to his writing, Ex-Mayor H. B. Rochester has just received a letter from an old school mate of his in Ottawa, Walter King, who is now connected with the auditor general's office in the federal capital and with whom he had not been in touch since he came west some twenty-five years ago.

Mr. King happened to have business in an antique shop in Ottawa and, while there, the proprietor showed him a handsome mahogany fire screen which was being designed for Baron Byng, Governor General, for use in his country home in England. Mr. King's attention was particularly attracted by a handsome caribou skin address that was being mounted in the centre of the screen. Closer examination showed that it was an address of welcome that had been presented by the citizens of Prince Rupert to the Governor General on the occasion of his visit here in 1922, the document being signed by "H. B. Rochester, Mayor." The writing of the letter which Mr. Rochester has just now received followed.

By this time, the local schooner Sea Maid, which has been in Seward for several weeks with a broken crank shaft, should be on the halibut chase again. According to word reaching the city, this week, the new crankshaft was to have arrived at Seward last Saturday and it was estimated that it would then take five or six days to get the vessel ready for operation. Henry Dorreen is captain of the Sea Maid and Leo Dorreen is chief engineer.

Peter Dorreen, the well known boat builder, after three weeks' illness in the hospital, is on deck again looking for work along the waterfront.

**Some Boat Deals**

In exchange for his old schooner Koyusu and a cash consideration of \$1,200, Capt. Dave Ritchie has become the owner of Alex Wylie's Unome, which was built here last year and operated for three months as a troller, it having been found that she was too large for such work. The Unome which is 40 feet in length with greater capacity than the Koyusu, has had a new pilot house put on and is now at McLean ways for finishing touches before being commissioned in the halibut game by Capt. Ritchie. She has a 16 h.p. Vivian engine.

Capt. Ritchie left yesterday on his farewell trip to the halibut banks with the Koyusu which will be turned over to Alex Wylie on his return. The Unome will then go out on her maiden trip in the halibut fisheries.

Another boat transaction of the past week involved the salmon packer Plop and the halibut schooner Hippo. The Plop was sold by John Clausen to Charlie Strachan and the former bought the Hippo from J. C. Gagigan. The Hippo will be used in salmon packing from Warke Channel, work in which the Plop was formerly engaged.

Versatility was demonstrated this week at the McLean shipbuilding shop where merry-go-round horses were being cut out for George White. Mr. White some time ago purchased the merry-go-round formerly operated on Acropolis Hill by Ben Seif and associates and it is his intention to fix the thing up and run it again at some site in town that has not yet been definitely selected. The old steeds had run themselves to death so are being replaced.

Capt. M. Hansen was giving his new salmon troller a workout on Thursday afternoon. The vessel, which is of the conventional type, has a 10 h.p. Frisbie engine.

The pleasure boat Interior, belonging to Matthias Shaw of Kitkatla, is in port at the end of this week having a 7 h.p. Palmer engine installed at the Ward ways in place of 5 h.p. Yale.
