government has resulted in an extraordinary situation. There is no government for the time being and the moment Rt. Hon. Arthur Meighen accepts the paid office of premier he loses his seat in the House. Any minister he appoints with portfolio also loses his seat. The creation of a Conservative government would, therefore, leave Mr. Meighen without a majority in the House unless he got either Liberal or Progressive support to wind up the business of the session. Mr. Meighen might, however, appoint an acting minister without salary and appoint one of his colleagues to represent him in the House temporarily.

The House meets again Tues-day afternoon.

Following the return of Rt. Hon. Arthur Meighen from an interview with the Governor General, he entered into a conference with prominent members of the Conservative party. It is stated, although unofficially, that Mr. Meighen has not yet been sworn

into the cabinet.
