**BUTTER PRICE IS FIRING UP**

Declines are Recorded in Potatoes Flour and Sugar Markets

The butter market, which has been wavering just above 50c has taken a strong turn and next week will see a retail charge of 55c straight on all varieties including the new stock of New Zealand butter which has just arrived.

Potatoes, which earlier in the fall threatened to scale dizzy heights in the matter of price, are easing up now. They are at present retailing in the city at \$3.25 and \$3.50 per sack.

Flour has declined 50c per barrel recently and sugar is down 10c per hundred since the last report.
