# NEW PROCESS TREATING ZINC

Leaching is to be Done at Ladysmith for Treating Complex Ores

VICTORIA, July 9.—David McBride, metallurgist and ore expert, who will have charge of the new process of lead and zinc separation, which is being introduced into British Columbia at the Ladysmith smelter, re-opened by a syndicate headed by Herbert Carmichael, and Henry B. C. Thomson, gave the first explanation of the new ore separation process, which is expected to mean so much to the mine operators of this Province, who by it will be able to recover both lead and zinc values, whereas now they can recover only one.

"I have just come from Colorado and Utah, where the separation of treatment of intimate mixtures of lead and zinc ores is a very live question," Mr. McBride said.

### Great Loss

"Hitherto such ores have been roughly concentrated and smelted, with a great loss of either the lead or the zinc, and some ores have been so complicated that they could not be treated at all.

"The new processes have for their object the separating of the lead and zinc before smelting, and in several cases the elimination of smelting entirely.

Leaching the finely-divided ore by chemical solvents has been the line taken by many chemists, and we have these divided more or less into two groups, which I might call the acid leachers and the alkaline leachers, the objects being in some cases to prepare a solution for precipitation by electricity and in others the precipitation of metallic salt or oxide useful in the arts without converting it into metal. For instance, oxide of zinc and basic sulphate of lead can be made and largely used as paint bases without first being converted into metal."

Mr. McBride was asked how he thought British Columbia ores would lend themselves to the new processes.

### Complex Problem

"From a study I have made of the British Columbia mines reports and from the mineral I have seen in the Provincial exhibit, I would say that these ores present quite a complex a problem as those of Colorado and Utah, and that the solving of the problem will mean a great deal in the development of new mines and increasing the output of those already shipping. Mr. McBride replied.

"Ladysmith seems to me to be admirably situated for an ore reduction plant, and when the mine owners find that they can get paid for a fair percentage of both the zinc and lead in their mixed ores, it will undoubtedly stimulate production and usher in a new era for the mines of the Coast.

### New Method

"With the reconstruction of the plant at Ladysmith, there will be an entirely new method of ore treatment, which should be profitable to that concern, while at the same time sharing that profit with the mine owners to the benefit of all concerned.

"The initial plant will require to be sufficiently flexible to treat the variety of ores offering on the Coast and capable of expansion to suit the kind and quality of mineral developed by the mines."

LONDON, July 9. — Krishnamurti, the young Hindu whom Mrs. Besant has brought forward as "the vehicle of the world teacher," was present at the meeting of the Theosophical Society on Saturday, when his mission was discussed. As is well known, the adoption of this cult by Mrs.

Besant, who is the society, has already caused division in its ranks throughout the world. For instance, the Canadian section has rejected the World Religion and Krishnamurti, the Czechoslovakian Society has seceded, there have been large secessions in Australia and South Africa, and generally every national society is in a state of turmoil.

### Mrs. Besant Challenges

The interest of Saturday's convention—it was held in private, but reports crept into some evening papers—was that for the first time since the upheaval of 1908 the commanding influence of Mrs. Besant was openly challenged to her face. W. Loftus Hare, who was until recently a member of the council, boldly questioned Mrs. Besant's right to "impose" Krishnamurti on the society. Mr. Hare's point was that the propaganda of a World Teacher does not come within the scope of the society's "three objects." The foundation of a new religion must compete with existing religions, whereas the society is friendly to all religions. Mr. Hare's resolution referred to the "New Messiah," as he is sometimes called (the title is rejected by the Theosophical Society), as "an alleged World Teacher."

Here was a polite but decided clash with the authority of Mrs. Besant, who declared that she would resign if she was not allowed the liberty of thought to which all members of the society were entitled. A rather colorless amendment "welcoming all new expressions of religious truths" was carried by an enormous majority, but those who refuse to accept Krishnamurti say it is doubtful whether the voting reflects the true division of opinion upon acceptance of the World Teacher.

### Handsome Man

Krishnamurti, a handsome young man who has been carefully trained from childhood for the role now thrust upon him, is living in strict seclusion at Wimbledon. Attempts by newspapers to interview him have all failed. It is said that he is to reside in Scotland, a wealthy believer there having put a house at the disposal of the movement, and that he will be surrounded by twelve apostles, seven of whom have been selected. A society known as the Order of the Star in the East exists to carry on the propaganda of this amazing cult.
