MILLION FEET LUMBER RAFT

CEDAR AND AIRPLANE SPRUCE LOGS ARRIVE FOR LOCAL MILL AT SEAL COVE

A Davis raft containing a million feet of cedar and some airplane spruce arrived here today from the T. A. Kelley Logging Co.'s camp on Queen Charlotte Islands in tow of the tug St. Faith for the Seal Cove Lumber Company.

The St. Faith is a new tug operated by the Powell River Paper Company and was brought here recently from Great Britain.

The vessel has one notable towing voyage to her credit. After the armistice she towed a 10,000-ton German steamer fully loaded with nitrate from Chili to Europe, via the Panama Canal.

This steamer had been lying idle for several years, and her bottom was covered with sea growth, but nevertheless good speed was made throughout the 8,000-mile tow.

Since arriving in British Columbia the St. Faith has been restored to Lloyd's 100 A1 class, for which she was designed and built, and has been fitted to burn fuel oil, the bunker capacity being arranged for twenty-five days continuous steaming. When fully loaded with fuel and stores the vessel will have an extreme draft of fifteen feet and a displacement of 1,000 tons.

OFFICIALS OF RAILWAY ARE DUE TOMORROW

J. E. DALRYMPLE, VICE-PRESIDENT IN CHARGE OF TRAFFIC, HEADS DISTINGUISHED PARTY

A large party of important Canadian National Railway officials, headed by J. E. Dalrymple of Montreal, vice-president in charge of traffic, will arrive in the city from Vancouver aboard the steamer Catala tomorrow and spend a day here on general inspection before proceeding East by train.

Beside Mr. Dalrymple, the party will include A. T. Weldon of Montreal, general traffic manager who, until recently, was traffic manager for the Atlantic region with headquarters in Moncton, N.B.; W. C. Moore of Montreal, manager of the C.N.R. express department; W. G. Manders, Winnipeg, freight traffic manager; R. Creelman, Winnipeg, passenger traffic manager; B. A. Latta, Edmonton, superintendent, Express department; J. M. Horn, Vancouver, general freight agent; G. A. McNicholl, Vancouver, general passenger agent; B. C. Keeley, Pacific coast manager, Canadian Government Merchant Marine; W. Hart, secretary to Mr. Dalrymple, and G. Stiven, secretary to Mr. Weldon.

EXPECT SUCCESS PORTLAND CANAL

SELUKWE GOLD MINING AND FINANCIAL COMPANY OPERATING AT STEWART HAS WIDE SCOPE

Word comes from Portland Canal that an ore discovery of major importance has been made on the B.C. Silver, says the Financial Post of Toronto. The location is given as a cross-cut from a shaft 75 feet below the lowest or N. 3 level. This is said to demonstrate that ore bodies persist to depths of 1000 feet or more.

London Mining World in a recent issue said regarding Selukwe and the B.C. Silver companies: "After wandering for years in the wilderness of disappointed hopes, this company seems at last on the threshold of a remarkable success, a success likely to be as conspicuous as that which attended its neighbor the Premier. If what we hear from Canada is true . . . we shall see most important developments on the Salmon River this season."

CONTROLLED IN BRITAIN

The Selukwe Gold Mining & Finance Company, Limited, a British mining concern, controls the B.C. Silver holdings in the Portland Canal. Selukwe also recently purchased the Bush Mines, supposed to have the northern continuation of the famous Premier vein. This property is now held by a subsidiary of Selukwe, called Sebakwe.

Selukwe owns 27 mining claims at Selukwe, Southern Rhodesia, Africa, and the holdings of the British Canadian Silver Corporation, Limited, with extensive

On the British Columbia holdings active development and exploratory campaigns are in progress.

SCHUFER CLAIMS

Selukwe also owns the Schufre property consisting of five crown-granted claims on the north slope of Hudson Bay Mountain, eleven miles from Smithers, B.C. This property shows silver-lead-zinc ore and also a pyrrhotite-zinc ore.

Selukwe holds 100,000 fully paid shares in Kafue Copper Development, Limited, operating in holdings and concessions amounting to 30 square miles in Northern Rhodesia in Africa. And in Canada Selukwe is interested through Kafue on a profit-sharing basis in a gold dredging area on Antler Creek in the famous old Cariboo district of British Columbia. In the same district Selukwe holds numerous alluvial gold mining claims along Cunningham Pass Creek adjoining Antler Creek.

BURMA AREAS VALUABLE

In Burma, Selukwe owns 120,000 shares of the capitalization of Shan States Silver-Lead Corporation, Limited. This corporation has three mineral areas in Burma, with a total of 1,183,265 acres. Considerable development work has been done on one of the Burma properties, the Bawzaing mine. The ore deposit is irregular, but appears to be about 300 feet in length and in places 80 feet in width, according to engineers' reports.
