**WATERFRONT WHIFFS****Yacht Club regatta June 24--Seining season about to start--trollers invaded city**

June 24, a week from next Thursday, will be a gala day on the Prince Rupert waterfront, it having been decided at an executive meeting this week to hold the second annual regatta of the Prince Rupert Rowing & Yacht Club on the afternoon of that day between the hours of 2 and 7 o'clock. Alex Macdonald, president of the club, under whose direction the event will be held, has excellent plans in hand and has already appointed members of the executive to head the various committees.

The program of events, which will be run off with the club floats as headquarters, will include four launch races and rowing races--mixed doubles, men's singles, women's singles, etc. The program of power boat races will include the handicap race, open to all boats belonging to the club, for the club cup now held by Skipper H. T. Cross. Another feature will be a sweepstakes handicap race open to all power boats in the harbor, relay race with two boats to a team and speed boat race, the entries in the last two mentioned events also being confined to club members. Suitable prizes are being arranged for the various events.

Refreshments will be served on the club floats and the Boys' Band has already been engaged for the occasion. The whole affair gives promise of being even more successful and attractive than the first regatta held last year by the club was.
