WATERFRONT WHIFFS

Improvement in salmon fishing is expected--halibut landings up to average--work at government wharf proceeding

While there has been no particular rush in the fish business during the past week the volume of halibut landed has been up to the average for the time of year and prices have remained at a fair margin. Prices offered on the Fish Exchange have averaged around 14.5c for Canadian and 15.5c for American first class catches while second class fish has fetched around 8c for both Canadian and American landings.

Halibut arrivals for the past week (Saturday to Friday inclusive) totalled 733,500 pounds—454,500 pounds from American boats and 279,000 pounds from Canadian. This West Coast of the Queen Charlotte Islands, around Dundas and on the Skeena River. However, a recent arrival in the city from North Island stated that the salmon run in that district had improved materially during the past week and good things were looked for. It is the general consensus of opinion that the backward summer is the only cause for the non-appearance of the salmon in surrounding waters but that with the continuance of the warmer weather things will improve rapidly.
