LEPER COLONY FORMOSA TODAY

Newspaper Tells of Work Being Done in Alleviating Sufferings of Patients

TAIHOKU, Formosa, July 8.—We have heard of the fearful leprosy disease, and again that Formosa is a leper country, says the Formosan Daily News. These lepers together reverence but one savior, the MacKay Memorial Hospital. We have been to visit the out-patient dispensary for lepers at this hospital. The day was Saturday. Each Saturday morning is wholly given over to the treatment of lepers.

The room for treatment is the other side of the dispensary, well situated for the admission of light and air. It is a section of the verandah which has been

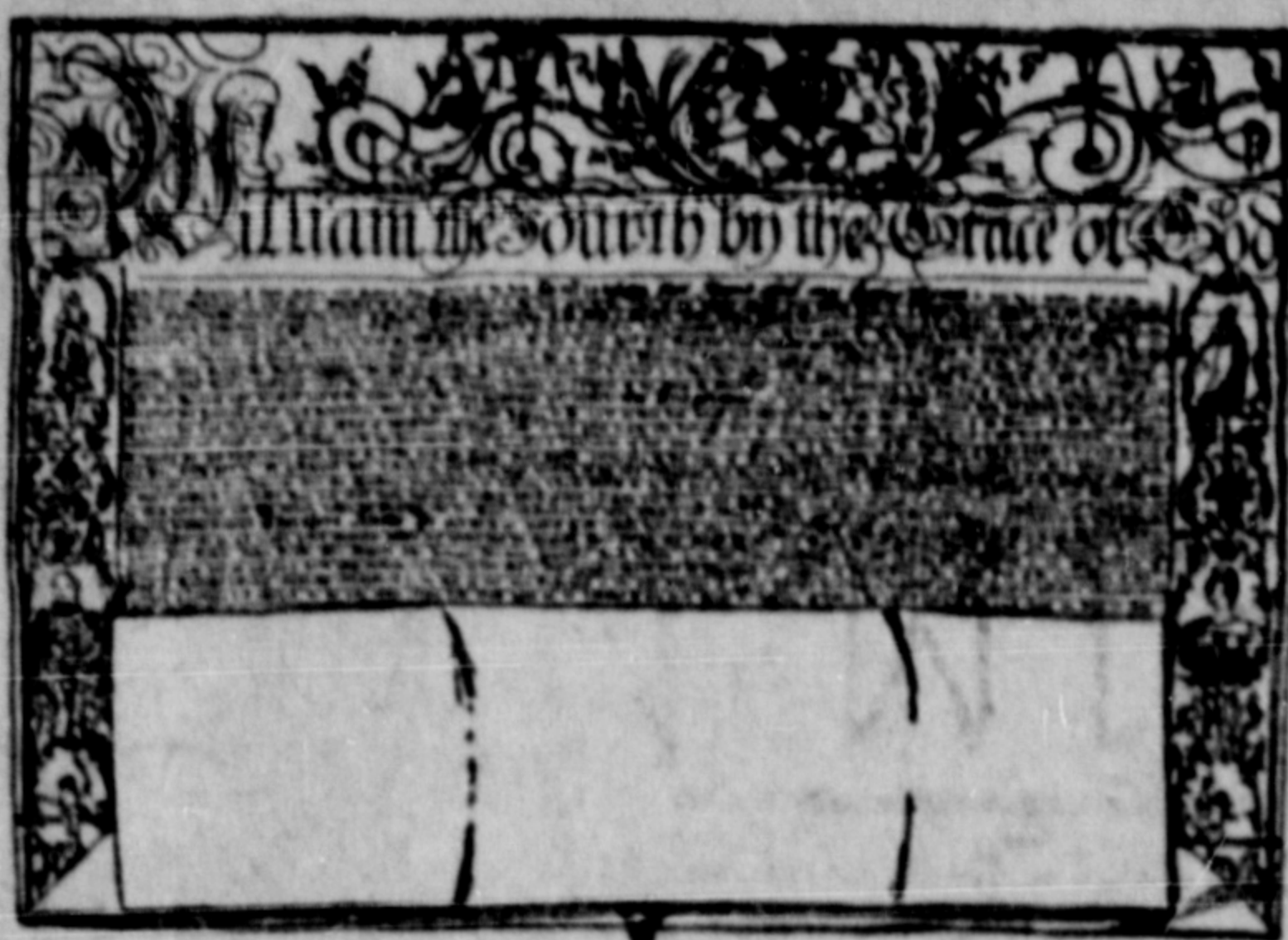

A CENTURY OLD CHARTER

enclosed and made into a little house. There the attendants are dressed in hygienic white clothes. Talking with lepers and writing their histories and treatment is Dr. Taylor. Again, like to Miss Nightingale, Nurse Mrs. Taylor's present, also young doctors and nurses doing work.

Ming's With Patients

Treatment begins at 8 o'clock. At this time the lepers have gathered. Dr. Taylor, using cleverly-spoken Formosan words, asks them one by one of their symptoms of the previous week and diagnoses their condition as each sits before him. From their answers he sees whether they have slightly altered or not, or any strange sign, or great pain, etc.

The doctor according to their condition prescribes medicine. If the patient needs a dressing, this is done, and then they go back to their homes. This is the work.

Each Saturday the number of patients is from fifty to 100, usually fifty to seventy. They come from many distant places.

The place has no notice board up, and it is not so very large a house. There are many lepers in the hospital, so that in the dispensary there is lots of life and movement.

Symptoms and Cure

Standing near the doctor's side is a young doctor injecting medicine. At the beginning of leprosy the body easily tires, memory fails, the skin in places has a tingling sensation like ants crawling over it, in the bones and ligaments comes a sensation of tightness, loss of the physical appearance of the face. From the injection of the medicine the tiredness goes, they can walk more naturally.

Then they take needful medicine which is not only one kind, sometimes many kinds are given. One week's medicine is seventy sen only, but, even so, only ten

out of seventy patients pay anything. All the others have free treatment, for these are poor people. To make up the deficiency, according to the doctor, the Canadian Church sends expenses.
