## CRIME RECORD WAS SHORT BUT STRENUOUS ONE

Man Who Was Executed at Week  
End Had Faithful Wife

BALTIMORE, Aug. 17.—Although at odds with the law from the age of short trousers, the criminal career of Richard Reese Whittemore, who was executed at the week end, left him cast in a pretty role until, at the age of 25 and with a noose dangling above his head, he crowded into the space of a few months most of the highlights of a fiction bandit's life.

He was a comparatively little-known gunman, with a prison reputation for being "hard," when serving a term for burglary, he walked out of Maryland penitentiary on February 26, 1925, with the keys of a mortally wounded guard. Thirteen months later, when a New York police night patrol picked him up as a suspicious character after a chase of guns' points from the door of a night club, he was the active head of one of the East's most successful criminal organizations of recent years.

### Went to Gallows

Whittemore went to the gallows for slaying the guard—Robert H. Holtzman—the first important act for his brief, spectacular career. Holtzman, his skull crushed by an iron bar, died two days after Whittemore escaped. Whether Whittemore actually was guilty of other murders laid by police at his door or that of his gang, may never be known.

Baltimore, New York, Chicago, Cleveland and Buffalo were included in the Whittemore gang's scope of operations. Many lucrative hauls were made from New York jewellery establishments. The "million dollar crime trust," so dubbed later by police because of the fabulous gains, and reported nearly

reached when the crime organization was shattered, revealed itself as an almost entirely self-supporting crime unit when police dug into its secrets. It had its own private "fences" for receiving stolen goods and maintained its own channels of disposal, realizing a much higher profit on its loot than is usually the case. The profits were apportioned among the gang members, the opportunity being made by Whittemore, who personally supervised its operations. So successful had the gang's system been that police at first declined to make public the details of a confession of Anthony Paladino, one of Whittemore's henchmen, on the grounds that it set a dangerous example.

Gang's Breakup

The gang's breakup was rapid after Whittemore and two companions visited the Chanteau night club in the early morning of March 19 last. He was trailed from the door by a roving patrol, forced from his automobile several blocks away, and taken to headquarters where his identity was established. The remainder of the gang were rounded up one by one, largely through a police watch on Mrs. Margaret Whittemore, the bandit chief's wife, who was living with him in a downtown hotel.

Wife Arrested

Mrs. Whittemore also was arrested in New York, but her bandit husband effected her release.
