(Edmonton Journal) The old rule dating back to the reign of Queen Anne, which required a member, on entering the cabinet, to return to his constituents for reelection, has been! abandoned by the mother of parliaments. Legislation to that end is to be introduced at Ottawa and one of the amendments to the Alberta legislative assembly act, which Mr. Brownlee has now in-

But conditions do arise, of which those at Ottawa at the present moment are a striking example, when it is a valuable safeguard. 
