

FORMER LOCAL MEN RESCUED FAMOUS ACTOR

CAPT. BABINGTON AND NORMAN BROADHURST FISHED MATHESON LANG OUT OF CHILLY WATERS.

The following item published reeently in a southern exchange told how two former well known Prince Rupert tug boat men figured in the rescue of Matheson Lang, a famous actor, from a cold, wet, real-life melodrama of a sudden immersion in the chilly waters of Erentwood Arm near Victoria:

While fishing on the Brentwood Arm. near Victoria, on Sunday, Matheson Lang, the actor, and a party of his friends were shipwrecked when their cabin cruiser crashed on a submerged rock and almost capsized, leaving crew and passengers stranded from from

Lang's stage manager stripped off his clothes, donned an old raincoat and volunteered to swim ashore to seek assistance. With a light cord tied around his waist, he dragged his clothes along behind him in a box to shore, where he dressed and plunged into the woods in search of aid.

Alarmed at the continued absence of M. Lang and his party, Captain Babington and Norman Broadhurst set out a launch to find them, and a waving lantern in the darkness disclosed the additional birds have been imported location of the stranded cruiser. The rescue was promptly effected.


