## B. MUSSOLINI AND HIS WORK

Outlines His Accomplishments In Triumphant Speech Made at Rome Recently

### EXECUTIVE AUTHORITY

Says Garrulous Parliamentary Institutions Must be Done Away With For Success

A recent speech of Benito Mussolini, Premier of Italy and usually now referred to as the "Duce" made a vigorous fighting speech recently in Rome in which he outlined his work both for the past and future.

The program of Fascism, as he interpreted it, said the Premier, was contained in the name, and that program still remained the same—namely, militant. He recalled how the newspapers had endeavored to ignore his existence, and how he had been defeated at the elections at the very juncture when the representatives of the old political system had begun their process of decomposition and disintegration of the state, which no longer did anything to check the rapacious and parasitic behavior of the old parties. There was a need for men with courage to found a new party which could overthrow those political elements.

war by another revolutionary act. They trembled often in their cowardice during the war. They gave the glorious troops, the victors of the Battle of Vittoria Veneto, neither triumph abroad, nor triumph at home. Those political elements which had dissipated the treasures of Italy's victory in a base and extraordinary fashion had to be dispersed and wiped out.

We accomplished that task, which is trying in vain to reorganise itself abroad, is the best testimony to the fact that we carried out a revolution. Then came the heavy responsibilities of governing the nation. It was a hard task, for we were surrounded by moral and material ruin, and the innumerable problems which had been many years awaiting a solution.

People were expecting the miracle to be achieved as they expect something great from every new man. Our task was immensely

to say that none of us, and in the first place myself, attaches any importance to what is said and written in foreign countries.

### Advise Other Countries

It is absolutely logical that the outside world of democratic Liberalism and plutocratic clannishness, which is without any country, should be against us. The counter-revolution, which

we have destroyed at home, and

You must give authority to the executive power. If you wish to live you must face the gravest problem of the century, the relations between capital and labor.

"Waiting for Something"

This problem, Signor Mussolini continued, has been completely solved by Fascism, by putting capital and labor on an equality before a common objective—namely, the prosperity and greatness of the nation.

Comrades, you are without doubt impatient through waiting for something. (Cries of assent.) When last year I promised you that we should succeed I kept my word to you. You will believe me if I tell you that your impatience will be satisfied one day?

Before I say anything on this subject, in which I share your anxiety, you must understand that you must be disciplined to an incredible extent in your daily work. The fateful hour is not always striking. The wheel of destiny is turning, and he is wise who is watchful and sees his opportunity when it comes.

### Divine and Adorable

Our divine and adorable Fascist Italy must be vigilant and firm in her work of peace. She must adapt herself to the necessities of work, and she must become systematic, tenacious, and persevering. I want to correct

Italians of some of their traditional faults—namely, their facile optimism and their negligence, often followed by excessive diligence, their excessive tendency to rest on their oars after an initial effort, their belief that everything will come out all right when very often the work has not been begun. If I succeed, and if Fascism succeeds,

in remodelling the character of Italians you may be easy in your minds, and rest assured that when the wheel of destiny passes we shall be prepared to seize it and to turn it according to our will. Comrades, it is a glorious

thing to live beneath our colors which have been blessed by the priests of the religion of our fathers, in which we believe. But it will be still more glorious if we have to die for our ideal.

The Prime Minister's speech was followed by frantic cheering.
