

TWO VIOLINS, VIOLA AND CELLO USED BY YOUNG NEW YORK QUARTETTE AGGREGATE \$175,000 IN VALUE

NEW YORK, Dec. 16 .- New York's youngest quartette at its next recital at the end of the year will play two viomade by Antonio Stradivari in the early days of the eighteenth century.

Stradivari violins are reputed to have the sweetest tones of any made. Of the thousands of instruments cherished by their owners as the product of the famous Italian instrument player only about 500 are genuine, experts say.. All these are now in museums or in coller tions of wealthy men and changes of ownership are easily traced.

The four century old instruments to be used by the quartette are owned by Felix M. Warburg. The members of the uartet are Sascha Jacobsen. Bernard Ocko, Louis Kaufman and Marie Romet-Rosanoff, the cellist.

The quartette was recently organized under the patronage of Mr. Warburg and other wealthy music lovers and gave its first concert a month ago.
