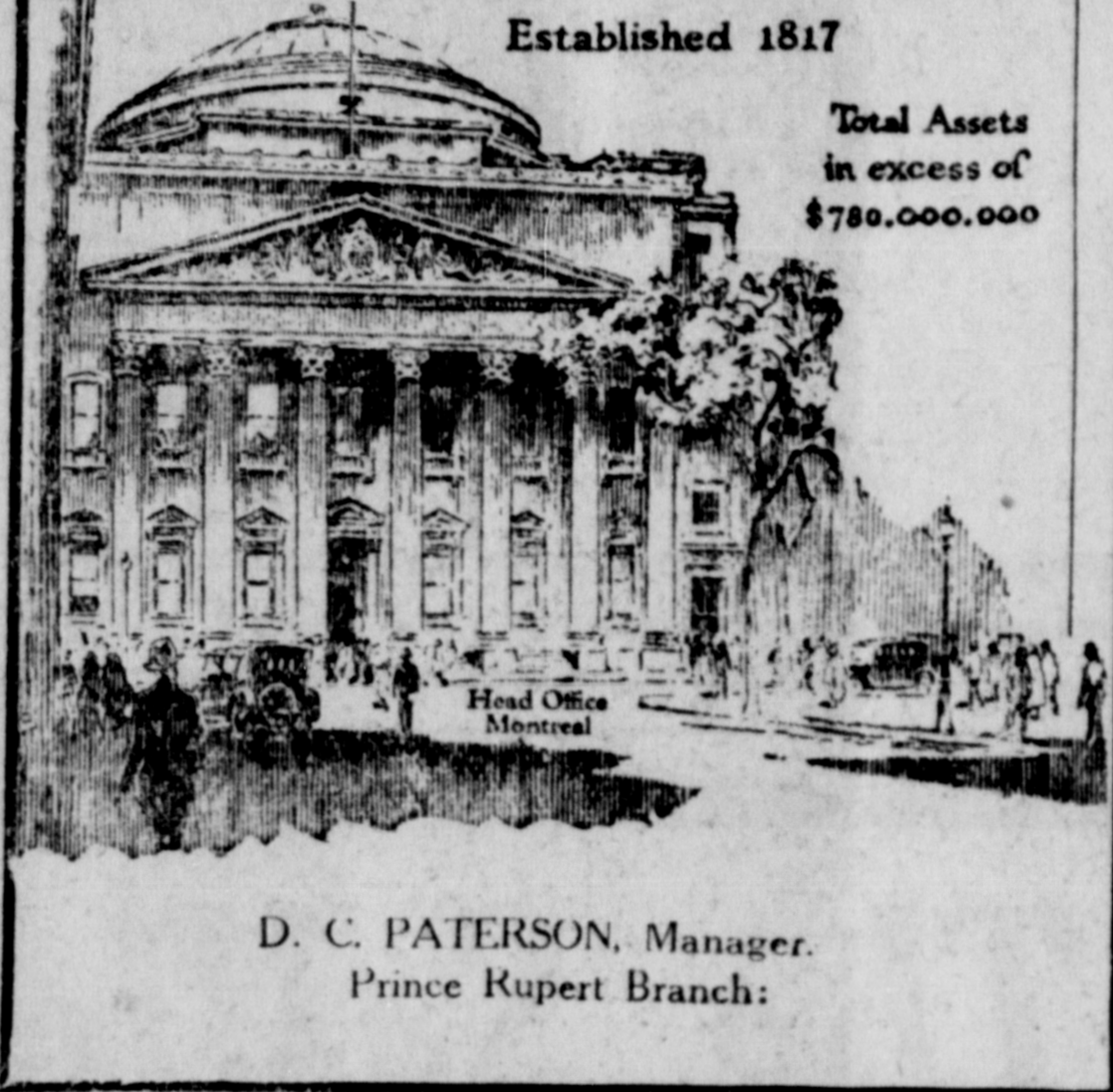

SAYS SETTLERS BEING DUMPED

MRS. E. R. COX, "WOMAN POLITICIAN OF NORTH," MAKES CHARGES IN VICTORIA

TALE OF WOE

VICTORIA, April 7.—Immigrants from England and other places, in the wilds of northern British Columbia are suffering, with their families, on the verge of starvation and almost being frozen by the long severe winter because they have not proper clothing and shelter, according to charges made here against immigration officials and organizations by Mrs. E. R. Cox, of Hazelton, known as the woman politician of the north country.

She is the niece of the late Captain Philip Hankin, who was governor of this country at the time of Confederation. She is the official interpreter in the north for the Supreme Court of Appeal and speaks four native dialects. She came down for the Sankey murder appeal.

HELPLESS AND STARVING

"We have had to keep several families of these poor immigrants through the winter," Mrs. Cox said. "What else could you do?" The poor people have been helpless there and starving. We have had to do it every winter recently. And since I arrived here I have received word that a lot more immigrants are arriving and are being dumped there.

"These people should be placed together in a town where they can be looked after. When the natives of the north find it hard to make a living, how can you expect these helpless, inexperienced people from London and other cities to eke out an existence? About an acre is all they can handle and they can't plant gardens to keep themselves alive, let alone raise surplus produce to market. Besides, some of the land they are put out on is so bad that they can't even raise a racket on it.

SENDING WRONG KIND

"The wrong kind of people are being sent into this northern country. It is not fair to the immigrants themselves. Not only are the transportation difficulties serious, but even if they should raise anything, the markets of the big cities are so far away and the shipping costs so high that they could not make anything."
