





Its importance is fully recognized by cold storage plants everywhere, whose operations would be practically impossible without it, as most of the effect of their refrigerating machinery would be required to overome heat from outside. Temperature conditions in the halibut fishery ar css severe than in many other indusries, but the present loss of ice shows learly that a great deal of undesirable heat gets into the holds. Whether the insulation now being used is sufficient can only be determined by experience; but it is obvious that the holds must be well insulated to give the full beneit of the refrigerating machines.

It would seem, on the whole, that 'he adoption of this equipment in the halibut fleet is an important step in advance. Present indications are favorable for satisfactory results. Those who are pioneering the movement are very confident of the outcome; and if their hopes are fulfilled, it is safe to say that from now on insulation and refrigerating machines will be standard equipment in the halibut fishery, at east for the larger boats working on he more distant banks, which must be lepended on in future for the greater part of the supply.
