



Victoria Times Offers to Make! Cut and Reproduce it at Own Expense

IS CASTING SUSPICION

Make Himsen Laughing Stock if Produced Evidence

(Victoria Times) R. H. Pooley's effort to discredit Conservatives friendly to Mr. Bowser seems to have got him into difficulties. We may be sure that when he told the B.C. Conservative Association in Vancouver that "a well-known Conservative" was in the pay of the Liberal party to make trouble and that he had ! evidence of this in photographic copies of cheques issued to this person, he did not realize what sort of a boomerang his charge would be.

Officers of the Victoria Conservative Association friendly to Mr. Bowser at once demanded proof of his charge and later one of them went to Mr. Pooley's office to see the photographs. Mr. Pooley, however, would permit this officer to see the photographs, only in confidence and that gentleman declined to examine them under that condition. We are informed that the Victoria Conservative Association will make a formal demand upon Mr. Pooley for the production of the evidence upon which he based his serious charge against a member of the party.

When Mr. Pooley made his accusation. Charles Spratt, president of the Victoria Liberal Association, denied that any Liberal money had been paid to any Conservative to betray his party, demanded the production of the evidence and offered to wager in the interests of some charitable institution that the charge was false as far as the Liberal party was concerned. In a rather unique statement in The Colonist Mr. Pooley says Mr. Spratt's challenge was based on "a suppositious case" set up by him. There was nothing suppositious about it. Mr. Pooley made a direct charge that a "well-known Conservative" had taken Liberal money to raise trouble in the Conservative ranks and Mr. Spratt just as directly denied it and challenged him to prove it.

Why all the mystery about this evidence which Mr. Pooley claims to have of the duplicity of some well-known Conservative-presumably a friend of Mr. Bowser? It cannot be very confidential because he admits he has shown these photographs to Conservative members of the Legislature and will show it to others. Why not let the Victoria Conservative Association see them without the condition that they shall preserve the mystery, so that, they, may purge their membership of the traitor who has been taking money from the wicked Grits? Does Mr. Pooley not realize that unless he makes public what he already has shown to so many in private he is casting suspicion upon the loyalty of a considerable element in the Victoria Conservative ranks? In his statement today he says he is going to consult Dr. Tolmie on the matter when the leader returns to the city. Are we to assume from this that the Doctor has been unaware up to this time of the important information which Mr. Pooley claims to have in his possession? Does the latter not think he should have taken his leader into his

confidence on this matter before now? The Times makes this sporting offer to Mr. Pooley. It will reproduce at its! own expense and print on its front page a photograph of any cheque in regard to this matter he has in his possession. Here is the chance in a life-time for Mr. Pooley to discredit the Conservative who, he says is disloyal, and also to score against the Liberals. Why not take it? How can he resist it?
